## Dr. M.N. DAS MEMORIAL YOUNG SCIENTIST AWARD-2026

## (Cash Award of ₹ 20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand only))

- 1. The Society of Statistics, Computer and Applications (SSCA) was founded in 1998 with the main objective of popularizing applications of statistical methodologies in different sciences and to provide incentives for developing indigenous computer software to help application activities in different technological areas. Candidates desirous of being considered for this award, may submit their full length research paper (soft copy) along with an abstract not running in more than 200 words and a passport-bio-data in the prescribed Application Form (enclosed), giving full name, date of birth (duly self-attested copy of certificate), affiliation, completed address for communication including Email and mobile number, research experience, list of publications (research papers in referred journals, books, book chapters, monographs, etc.) and a recent passport size photograph. The research paper and

the passport-bio-data may also be accompanied with a "No Objection Certificate" from all the co-authors (wherever applicable), stating clearly that they have no objection in

the research paper being considered for the MNDM YSA -2026 as well as a certificate

from the author that the <u>research has not been published or accepted for</u>

publication anywhere in India or abroad on the day of submitting the

<u>nomination.</u> The guidelines for preparing and sending of papers for the award are

provided at the above mentioned website of the Society (under the link "Journal"; one

can also reach directly using <a href="https://ssca.org.in/journal.html">https://ssca.org.in/journal.html</a>). <a href="https://ssca.org.in/journal.html">The guidelines should</a>

be strictly adhered to. Any deviation from the prescribed guidelines will invite rejection

of the paper for the competition.
